Newly elected President Rusty Woodward stated, “with our 2nd birthday celebrations coming up in April, this is another great step forward for the Club”.

Officially launched by the Chief Minister on 11 April 2008, the Club was started as part of Communities@Work’s Community Development Program, which is funded by the ACT Government. A need for such a Club was identified by the Ministerial Advisory Council on Ageing and through local research.

The Club is a great way to meet people, make new friends and have fun. Membership is open to anyone 50 plus who wants to get out and about. Members participate in local and interstate excursions as well as a variety of indoor activities such as exercise, jazzercise and Tai Chi classes, digital photography, art classes, indoor bowls, table tennis, cards and much more.

“Being recognised as an Incorporated Association is an important milestone in our history”, continued Rusty Woodward. “We have a very active committee and now we are incorporated, we can start to take over responsibilities formerly managed by Communities@Work, heralding a new era in the growth of the Club”.
